Do It Yourself



For best results, use professional vector programs like Illustrator, Coreldraw, or similar. Home programs like MS Word/Publisher don't have the right tools or colour palette. MS Excel is for spreadsheets. MS Powerpoint is for screen slideshows. PhotoShop is for editing bitmap images.

Use the allBIZ ONLINE EDITOR (1)



Type your text (and/or add a logo) in the art box area. (No "safe area" needed.)

NOTE: For the best result:

Use a plain, simple font (sans serif)

Minimum font size: 6pt

If using a logo and printing one colour, use a one colour version of your logo * If printing white onto a coloured pen, use BLACK (it will be converted)

MAKE SURE YOUR FILES ARE PRINT READY! Your job could be ruined by bad files. Fuzzy, wrong colours/fonts, missing **PDF** (PDF/X-1a is better) bits and more. Wrong files could be rejected/charged a processing fee. FONTS embedded (or converted to Curves/Paths/Outlines) IMAGES 300ppi **COLOUR** One Colour use PMS, or Full Colour use CMYK FLATTEN transparencies/layers (or you will get odd stripes/blocks)
